It is used as:

3. Used to talk about actions that will be completed by a certain future time.

Example:

1. By this time tomorrow I shall have reached my home.
2. I shall have done my work on time.
3. I shall have finished my work before he comes.
4. You will have met your mother before I see you again.
5. This book is not long. I will have read it by lunch time.
