The verb "to have" has 2 forms in the present tense. They are – <u>Have</u>, <u>Has</u>. Its second form in past tense is <u>Had</u>. It is used in formation of the Perfect Tense.

- 4. They <u>have</u> Been invited for the lunch.
- 5. You should <u>have</u> attended the meeting.
