## VERB

### OUGHT:

*It is used as:*

- # *To express moral obligation, duty and desirability. "Ought to" can indicate present or future time. It is always followed by "to".*

*Example:*

1. *The boy ought to have worked hard.*
2. *You ought to do it by sunset.*
3. *You ought to have advised your son.*
4. *I ought to have helped her.*
5. *She said I ought To write to my mother.*
