1. Verbs, which shows actions completed or perfected in the far away past.

It is formed as:

2. Subject + Had + Third Form Of The Verb

Example:

The girls had taken their lunch.

It is used as:

3. When action had been completed before another was commenced.

Example:

- 1. I had reached the school before the bell rang.
- 2. Tanaji had lost his life in the action.
- 3. I had done my exercise when Hari came to see me.
- 4. Harry had died before the doctor came.
- 5. Ladies had sung several bridal songs.
