# PRESENT PERFECT TENSE:

 Verb shows that the action is mentioned as finished, complete or perfect at the time of speaking.

## It is formed as:

2. Subject + Has Or Have + Third Form Of The Verb

# They have washed their hands.

- 3. To indicate completed activities in the immediate past (with just) as -
- 4. To express past actions whose time is not given and not definite as -
- 5. To denote an action beginning at same time in the past and continuing up to the present moment as -

#### Example:

- 1. Have you read Gulliver's travel?
- 2. I have lived in Poona for five years.
- 3. Gopi has eaten all the biscuits.
- 4. We have thanked our stars.
- 5. The boys have learnt their lessons.
