

PRONOUN

REFLEXIVE PRONOUN:

1. Are formed by adding <u>self</u> or <u>selves</u> to personal pronouns.

Example:

- 1. She wants all of us to be around <u>herself.</u>
- 2. The injured workers helped one another.
- 3. She put <u>herself</u> to trouble for nothing.
- 4. I myself went there.
- 5. The queen <u>herself</u> came to see her sick maid.
- 2. Reflexive Pronouns are used in three ways:
 - 1. As objects to refer to the subjects normally:

Example:

- 1. I fell over and hurt myself.
- 2. She wants all of us to be around herself.
- 2. To emphasize (lay stress on) a noun:

Example:

- 1. The queen herself came to see her sick maid.
- 2. I have done this job myself.
- 3. As reciprocal pronouns:

Example:

- 1. Vimala and Kamala love each other.
- 2. The injured workers helped one another.
