PRONOUN

REFLEXIVE PRONOUN:

1. Are formed by adding self or selves to personal pronouns.

Example:

1. She wants all of us to be around herself.
2. The injured workers helped one another.
3. She put herself to trouble for nothing.
4. I myself went there.
5. The queen herself came to see her sick maid.

2. Reflexive Pronouns are used in three ways:

1. As objects to refer to the subjects normally:

Example:

1. I fell over and hurt myself.
2. She wants all of us to be around herself.

2. To emphasize (lay stress on) a noun:

Example:

1. The queen herself came to see her sick maid.
2. I have done this job myself.

3. As reciprocal pronouns:

Example:

1. Vimala and Kamala love each other.
2. The injured workers helped one another.
