

# ARTICLE

## REPETITION OF THE ARTICLE:

1. When two or more Adjective qualifies the same Noun, the Article is used before the first the first Adjective only; but when they qualify different Nouns, expressed or understood, the Article is normally used before Adjective.

#### Example:

- # I have a black and a white dog.
- 2. When two or more connected nouns refer to the same person or thing, the Article is ordinarily used before the first only; but when two or more connected nouns refer to different persons or things, the Article is used before each.

#### Example:

- # The Secretary and the Treasurer are absent.
- 3. In expressing a comparison, if two nouns refer to the same person or thing, the Article is used before the first noun only.

### Example:

- 1. He is a better mechanic than clerk.
- 2. He is a better poet than novelist.
