SIMPLE ADVERB OF DEGREE OR QUANTITY:

It indicates how much or to what extent a thing is done such adverbs are called <u>Adverbs</u> <u>Of Degree Or Quantity</u> such as somewhat, very much, fully, too etc.

Example:

- 1. I feel <u>somewhat</u> puzzled at it.
- 2. He was very tired.
- 3. You are <u>altogether</u> mistaken.
- 4. He was partly pleased.
- 5. These mangoes are <u>almost</u> ripe.
