

CONJUNCTION

SUBORDINATING CONJUNCTION:

The Conjunction which joins one statement to another on which it depends for its full meaning is called as Subordinating Conjunction.

Example:

- 1. I shall work hard when I appear in the test.
- 2. He is so tired <u>that</u> he cannot walk anymore.
- 3. I shall come wherever you want me to come.
- 4. Walk fast <u>lest</u> you should miss the train.
- 5. He worked hard that he might pass.
