CONJUNCTION

SUBORDINATING CONJUNCTION:

The Conjunction which joins one statement to another on which it depends for its full meaning is called as Subordinating Conjunction.

Example:

1. I shall work hard when I appear in the test.
2. He is so tired that he cannot walk anymore.
3. I shall come wherever you want me to come.
4. Walk fast lest you should miss the train.
5. He worked hard that he might pass.
